



PROTECTION FRAMEWORK

EN ISO 20345: 2011 – Safety footwear used for general purposes. It includes, for example, mechanical risks, slip resistance, thermal risks, ergonomic behaviour.

For professional use:

Fishing – agriculture... or other activities requiring this kind of protection.

CATEGORY 2 PPE

(PPE = Personal Protective Equipment)

And complies with EU regulation 2016/425.

PERFORMANCE

EN ISO 20345 (S5+CI)

S5 = Basic safety requirements + Antistatic footwear + energy absorption in the heel region (20J) + protection against penetration + toe cap + metallic protective insole.

CI = Cold insulation (extra thermal insulation down to -40°C)

PRINCIPAL MATERIALS

Polyurethane

Easy to clean and disinfect.

INSTRUCTIONS

- **CARE**
 - Clean the boots after every use with water and soap, using a soft brush.
 - Rinse away the remains of the detergent with water.
 - Allow to dry well at room temperature and in the shade.
- **STORAGE**
 - Store the boots in a well-ventilated and dry place.

ILLUSTRATION AND INSTRUCTIONS



For maximum protection, check the condition of your boots thoroughly before each use.

DO NOT USE the boots if the protective parts (i.e. toe cap, sole) are damaged.
